VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to send the attendance of the petitioners to respondent No.3 to enable the petitioners to appear in the examination.
2. Learned State Counsel has submitted that the present writ petition is of the year 2018 and no interim relief has been granted in favour of the petitioners and the examination has already been held in 2018 and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he is not in touch with the petitioners and thus, the present writ petition, at this

stage, be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the petitioners to move an application for restoration of the present writ petition in case any cause survives to them.

4. Accordingly, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage.

5. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioners to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to them.
