Present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents not to change the nature of Graveyard against the settled principle of law of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and further to take action on the applications dated 29.05.2018 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) and application dated 15.07.2018 (Annexure P-9) by passing a well reasoned and speaking order.

Notice in this petition was issued and in response thereto, reply on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4 has already been filed.

Learned counsel for respondents No.3 and 4 submits that property has already been leased out and if the petitioner is aggrieved by

the same, he has the remedy of challenging the same, which remedy has not been availed so far.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for respondents No.3 and 4, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy as available to him for the redressal of his grievance in accordance with law.
