ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Seeking protection of her life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.5 & 6, the petitioner has come up before this Court.

2. On instructions from Inspector Ram Rattan, SHO, Police Station, Sector 31, Chandigarh, counsel for the UT states that the police officials are discharging their lawful duty to arrest son of the petitioner who is an accused in a cognizable non-bailable offence and further his bail has been dismissed by the trial court. He further submits that the petitioner has nothing to fear from respondents No.5 & 6.

3. Counsel for the State of Punjab has also given the similar assurance as UT counsel has given.

4. Given above, no further orders are required to pass in the present petition and the same is disposed of. Liberty reserved to the

petitioner to approach this Court again, in case, she feels any threat in future.
