Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to implement the order dated 31.10.2017 passed by respondent No.4 who has ordered the respondent No.6 Naib Tehsildar-cum-Receiver to hand over the possession of the land attached under Section 146 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner.

It has been contended by counsel for the petitioner that the issue involved between both the sides have already been settled upto the Hon'ble Supreme Court and it is on account of the same, the order dated 31.10.2017 was passed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate directing the Naib Tehsildar, Patiala to hand over the possession of the land in dispute to Party No.1 i.e. the petitioner. He submits that despite the order, till date no action has been taken by the respondents-authorities for complying the said order. He submits that having no other option, petitioner filed the representation dated 31.05.2023 before the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala for the redressal of his grievance but even on the representation, no

decision has been taken by the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Patiala, District Patiala is directed to decide the representation (Annexure P-16) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within two weeks from today in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
