After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the impugned order has been passed by the Director General, Health Services, Haryana, the petitioner intends to approach the Government for the redressal of his grievance by filing appropriate representation and the respondents be directed that in case the petitioner files any representation, the same be decided expeditiously in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by the competent authority in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation by passing an appropriate

speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to her within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
