SURESHWAR THAKUR, J.(ORAL)

1. The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant writ petition.

2. Leave is granted.

3. Consequently, the extant writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to forthwith institute a petition under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act of 1961') before the learned Collector concerned. On such a petition being forthwith instituted, before the learned Collector concerned, the same shall be decided, but, positively within a period of 6 months of its preferment. However, the decision which becomes made on the said petition, shall be so recorded, but, after an opportunity being granted to all concerned, to raise their respective pleadings, and, also after issues being formulated on

such pleadings, and thereafter, all the contesting litigants being permitted to adduce their respective evidence(s) thereon. Moreover, the Collector of the revenue district concerned is also directed to regularly monitor the progress, as, made on the petition to be filed under Section 11 of the Act of 1961.

4. Cost of Rs.5000/-, as becomes imposed by this Court, on 14.11.2022, upon the Gram Panchyat concerned, be ensured to be forthwith deposited by the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat concerned, before the Treasurer of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association.

5. Disposed of accordingly.
