1. The petitioner has assailed the order dated 03.05.2023 passed by the learned Family Court, Ferozepur vide which maintenance @ Rs.8000/- p.m. has been awarded in favour of respondent No.1.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled between the parties. The petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs. 13 Lakhs to respondent No.1 on account of permanent alimony. The petitioner and respondent No.1 have instituted a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of marriage by mutual consent in the learned Family Court, Moga. A sum of Rs. 6 lakhs has already been paid and the balance amount of Rs. 7 Lakhs shall be paid when the statements of the parties is recorded at the stage of 2nd motion.
3. In these set of circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he has instructions to withdraw the present petition without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to seek revival of the petition, in the event the amicable settlement fizzles out at any subsequent stage.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
