1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 to 4 to conclude the inquiries against respondent No.6 which are pending for the last three years and take action on the complaint dated 14.07.2015 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned State Counsel has submitted that in the present case, the inquiry has been conducted and it has been found that respondent No.6 has embezzled an amount of Rs.42,133/- and the said amount has been deposited by respondent No.6 and thus, necessary action, in accordance with law, has been taken and accordingly, the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
