1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had worked as Sweeper-cum-attendant for some time with the respondent-department but thereafter, his services were discontinued.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that even as of now, sweepers are being deployed by the respondents through outsourcing basis hence, the petitioner intends to approach the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited for empaneling his name also for deployment in any department of the Haryana Government, which has requirement of the sweepers.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any application is filed by the petitioner with the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited seeking impanelment of his name, the same will be processed in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed

within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such request and in case it is found feasible to include the name of the petitioner in the panel so as to deploy him through outsourcing in any department, the said benefit will also be given to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited for impanelment of his name for deployment as sweeper in any department of the Haryana Government.
