The present petition has been filed for quashing of the order dated 17.01.2014 (Annexure P-6) vide which the claim for compassionate appointment was rejected as his father was in Government Service.

The petitioner claimed compassionate appointment on the death of his mother who was serving as a teacher with the respondent. The claim of the petitioner was examined and rejected on the aforesaid ground. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said ground was erroneous as the father of the petitioner has already left his mother and was living with some other lady. Upon inquiry made of there being any judicial order of separation or any other order passed by the Family Court, learned counsel states that there is no such order in other Court with regard to judicial separation of the mother of the petitioner with father of the petitioner.

In view of the above circumstances, the contention raised by the petitioner can not be accepted as such statement can be made in all

for interference is made out, as such claim of the petitioner is dismissed.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
