1. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in the case bearing FIR No. 122 dated 02.08.2021 under Section 376 IPC read with Section 4 of the POCSO Act registered at Police Station E, Division Amritsar.
2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has been convicted and sentenced by the learned trial Court in terms of the judgment dated 13.10.2023 and the present petition has become infructuous.
3. In view of the categoric assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
