By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C for seeking the issuance of direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to conduct fair, impartial and independent investigation in a time bound manner in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.0012 dated 28.01.2023 registered at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 498-A & 406 IPC and also to get the Look Out Circulars issued against respondents No.4 to 6 and seek their deportation as they are, presently, residing in Dubai.

2. Mr. Kunwarbir Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in this case in pursuance of the copies of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh from the afore-referred police station, he informs the Court that the

Look Out Circulars were sought to be issued against respondents No.4 to 6 on 23.06.2023 but the concerned Authority has raised certain objections and after the removal of those objections, the matter qua the issuance of the Look Out Circulars against the said respondents would be pursued expeditiously.

3. In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, at this stage.

4. Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

5. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
