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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for New India Assurance Company-Respondent No.3 and National Insurance Company-Respondent No.6, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.1,60,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellant-Satish Kumar S/o Chander Bhan, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to both the Insurance Companies (respondent No.3 and respondent No.6) to deposit cheque(s) in the sum of Rs.80,000/- each (Rs.1,60,000/- in total) favouring the appellant-Satish Kumar S/o Chander Bhan, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 13.03.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque(s)/draft(s) from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy(ies) of the cheque(s)/draft(s) bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
