SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J. (ORAL)

The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 439 Cr.P.C., has been invoked for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 15, dated 12.01.2022, under Sections 364-A IPC and Sections 25 of Arms Act (added later on), registered at Police Station City, Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that during the trial parties have entered into a compromise as the registration of afore-said FIR was the result of mis-understanding between the parties.

The custody certificate of the petitioner filed by learned State counsel is taken on record. According to which, the petitioner is behind bars for the last 1 Year and 28 days and admittedly, he is not involved in any other

of any nature.

Ms. Anmol, Advocate appearing on behalf of complainant-Sanju Sharma has not controverted the factum of compromise and submits that no grievance is left for continuation of proceedings.

Be that as it may, considering the statement made by the counsel for the complainant and the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner apart from the fact that there is strong probability of the petitioner to be acquitted in the instant case, this Court is of the considered view that no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.

However, it is made clear that the observations made hereinabove, shall have no bearing on the merits of the trial.
