Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the State to register a FIR against the private respondents for the offences alleged to have been committed by them as detailed in the petition.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that acting on the representation made by the petitioner, the State had registered a FIR against the private respondents as also a cross case against the petitioner and that the investigation of the FIR registered at the behest of the petitioner has revealed that the private respondents have committed offences under Sections 325, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and accordingly, the State shall shortly file its final report before the competent Court under Section 173 Cr.P.C. seeking therein to prosecute the private respondents under the afore-referred Sections of the IPC.

In the light of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.
