The present writ petition had been filed for seeking compensation on account of death of father of petitioners No.1 and 2 and husband of petitioner No.3 due to electrocution.

It has been averred in the petition that Shankar Lal son of Lal Chand was going from the fields when an electricity wire was snapped and as a result of injuries sustained due to electrocution, compensation has been prayed for.

Written statement on behalf of respondents has been filed as per which an amount of Rs.6,52,280/- has been sanctioned as compensation to the legal heirs of the deceased under the policy and that the said amount has also been accepted by the petitioners. A reference was also made to the acknowledgement signed by Smt. Sukhi Devi widow of Shanker Lal (Annexure R-1).

It has also been pointed out that the incident in question took place on 18.12.2019 and the compensation policy dated 15.07.2019 was in force on the said date.

Learned counsel contends that in the event there is any subsisting claim under the above said policy and in case the petitioners so choose to prefer a claim in terms of the aforesaid policy, the same shall be considered and in case any additional amount is found payable the same shall also be released to them.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned counsel for the respondent Distribution Licensee, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the respondent-Authorities for redressal of their grievances.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberties as aforesaid.
