AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

On 29.11.2023, following order was passed:-

“It is stated by counsel for the appellants that if, an amount of Rs.7,50,000/- is paid over and above the amount already paid, the issue involved in this appeal can be settled. Counsel for the appellants has also signed the proposal sheet.

To us, this offer seems to be just, reasonable and equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case. Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company prays for time to get concurrence from the concerned authority.

Mr. Chetan Kapoor, Advocate with Mr. Arun K. Gupta, Advocate for the appellants signed the consent proposal on 29.11.2023, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.7,50,000/-(Rupees Seven Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal.

As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellants as per MACT award.

Mr. Nigam K. Bhardwaj, Advocate for respondent No.3-Insurance

Company has also signed the said statement today, accepting the proposal

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made by the counsel for the appellants.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed cheques in the sum of Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) in the respective names of all the appellants in the same proportion as awarded by MACT with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 05.02.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
