The appellants have filed the present appeal impugning the order dated 13.07.2023 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur in case FIR No.30 dated 14.6.2023 under Sections 323, 341, 34 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amendment 2015) registered at P.S. Cheema, District Sangrur whereby they have been declined the relief of anticipatory bail.

Learned Counsel for the appellants submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 31.07.2023 passed by this Court, apellants have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the appellants have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 31.07.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 31.07.2023 is made absolute.

However, the appellants shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
