1. The petitioner in the present petition is claiming appointment on the post of Driver for Heavy Transport Vehicles in Transport Department, Haryana as advertised through advertisement No.4/2017 in category No.1 i.e. BCB Category wherein, 2038 posts were advertised.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-State Commission at the outset submits that all the posts which were advertised have already been filled up.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per his information certain posts in the category concerned are still lying vacant.

5. At this stage, in view of the statement given by learned State counsel, learned counsel for petitioner submits that the respondents may kindly be directed that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner raising his claim qua the post which are lying vacant, the same be considered in accordance with law and the merit obtained by the petitioner and in case the

petitioner is found eligible, he be considered against the vacant post as per his merit.

6. The learned State counsel submits that in case any such representation is received from the petitioner, the same will be considered and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation and after deciding the such representation in case petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will also be extended to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks

7. Keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
