Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for quashing of FIR No.124 dated 24.08.2015, under Sections 307, 148, 149, 427 IPC and 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act (Section 307 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act have been deleted vide enquiry report dated 22.11.2017 and Section 336 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran, Punjab (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 11.08.2022 (Annexure P-4 and P-5).

As per report dated 30.11.2022, received from the Court of Ld. JMIC, Patti, statement of petitioner No.2 Raman Joshan and respondent No.3 Gursewak Singh have not been recorded as they did not appear in the Court. It has also been stated that in FIR No.09 dated 23.01.2016, Subash Chander, Raman Joshan, Rishab Joshan and Shamer Chand are declared proclaimed offenders.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.
