Admittedly, the petitioners were appointed for a particular educational session as the educational volunteers under the Sarva Siksha Abhiyan Scheme. The petitioners were recruited for a fixed term. However, their relieving from the service was delayed on account of the imposition of the Code of Conduct. The learned counsel representing the petitioners have failed to draw the attention of the Court to any right to continue after the expiry of the session. Various identical writ petitions filed in this Court including **Civil Writ Petition No.24978 of 2012, titled as “Mandeep Kaur and others Vs. State of Punjab and others”**, were dismissed on 05.02.2013.

Though, the learned counsel representing the petitioners was time and again requested to draw the attention of the Court to any infringement of the service, rules, regulation or instructions, but he failed to do that.

Hence, the writ petition is dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
