1. In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the order dated 11.01.2016 (Annexure P-3) by which, the claim for medical reimbursement raised by the petitioner has been rejected.

2. As per the reply filed, the respondents reconsidered the claim of the petitioner and have already released a sum of Rs.5,19,369/- to the petitioner. As per the respondents, the claim of the petitioner has been considered keeping in view the instructions issued and the amount for which the petitioner was entitled for, have already been released to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing has come on record as to what amount of reimbursement sought by the petitioner, has been declined by the respondents so that the petitioner should know whether the same has been declined rightly or not.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received by the petitioner seeking the details of the amount allowed and reasons for rejecting certain claim, the same will be provided to the petitioner immediately within a period of four weeks for appropriate information and action of the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents.
