1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to restrain the private respondents No.4 to 6 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to look into his complaint dated 06.07.2023 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. On asking of the Court, Ms. Trishanjali Sharma, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to look into

the complaint dated 06.07.2023 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law.
