Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondents No.1 and 2 to take action in pursuant to report dated 25.06.2013 (Annexure P-3) submitted on account of unauthorized construction raised by respondents No.3 and 4 without sanction of building plans as well as encroachment made on the public road.

This Court vide order dated 16.08.2023 had granted more time to respondents No.1 & 2 to comply with the order dated 28.07.2023. In response to the same, short reply by way of an affidavit of Vijay Kumar Yadav, Joint Commissioner-II, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2 has been filed today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for respondents No.1 & 2 has drawn attention of this Court to the reply filed wherein it is specifically mentioned that the Junior Engineer on 13.09.2023 had visited the site and found no encroachment as alleged and thus, this petition is rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for respondents No.1 & 2, nothing survives in the present petition and accordingly, the same is disposed of.

The petitioner would be at liberty to avail his remedies as available to him in case of his having any surviving grievance.
