Prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the official respondents to get released alleged detainee, namely, Ravneet Kaur, from the illegal confinement of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that marriage of the petitioner and the alleged detainee was solemnized on 25.08.2022, as per the Sikh rites and rituals and that the alleged detainee-wife of the petitioner, has illegally been detained by the private respondents and has been physically and mentally harassed.

In pursuance of the order dated 26.07.2023 passed by this Court, short reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dera Baba Nanak, Police District Batala, has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record. The aforesaid reply is annexed with the statement of the alleged detainee. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned opposite counsel.

In her statement, the alleged detainee stated that she left the matrimonial home and had come to the parental house of her own will and she is now residing there happily without any pressure.

Faced with the aforesaid situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
