1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for setting aside the order dated 06.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Special Judge, Hoshiarpur in FIR No.72, dated 26.06.2021, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Talwara, Hoshiarpur vide which the non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner and to allow the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and to continue on the previously furnished bail bonds and surety bonds which are still in existence as the same were never cancelled and forfeited by the Court.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in pursuance of the last order passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the learned trial Court and he has also furnished his bail bonds and therefore, the present petition has become redundant.

3. In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is disposed of as having become redundant.
