The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 20.08.2019, vide which while allowing the petition, the State was directed to release the amount of subsidy/investment incentives forthwith in terms of sanction letter dated 09.08.1999 (Annexure P1) along with interest @ 6.5% per annum from the date of filing the instant writ petition.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the amount has not been paid.

As per the reply filed by the Secretary-cum-Director of Industries and Commerce, Punjab, an application was filed in the aforesaid writ petition and on 12.10.2022, the order was modified and it was directed that the amount of capital subsidy shall be deposited with the Registry of this Court, subject to final outcome of the application.

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Be whatsoever, from the aforesaid order dated 12.10.2022, the respondents have already deposited the amount with the Registrar of this Court on 18.11.2022.

In view of the above, there is no willful disobedience and the petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the Writ Court for clarification of the order, if need be.
