HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are some posts of Staff Nurse, which are lying vacant in the category in which the petitioner had applied for, keeping in view the fact that certain candidates, who were selected, did not join in pursuance to offers of appointment made to them, hence, the petitioner has a right to be considered against one of the advertised posts, which is lying vacant in her category.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner further submits that grievance as raised in the present writ petition has already been raised vide legal notice dated 22.05.2023 (Annexure P-8), hence, the petitioner will be satisfied in case time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pankaj Midha, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, legal notice dated 22.05.2023 has not been decided by the authorities concerned by passing an appropriate speaking order, the same will be done within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case the petitioner is

found entitled for any benefit after the said decision, the same will be extended to the petitioner within a further period of 4 weeks.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.
