JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.

The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.351 dated 09.11.2004 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (P-2).

The learned counsel for the petitioner while relying on the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28.08.2006 contends that the matter had been settled and the statement of the counsel for the complainant had been recorded that he had received the full amount. He, therefore, contends that the present FIR be quashed on the basis of the compromise.

None appears on behalf of the respondent No.2.

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The learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, contends that there is no reference in the aforesaid order that a quashing petition based on a compromise would be filed.

Faced with this situation, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he wishes to withdraw the present petition.

In view of the above, the present petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
