With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the hearing in the main case, which is listed for 23.11.2023, is preponed to today.

On November 16, 2023, we had passed the following order in CM-19328-CWP-2023:

“This is an application praying for issuance of interim directions to the respondents to keep one plot measuring 6 marlas reserved for the applicants-petitioners in Sector 13, Urban Estate, Panipat, as all the available plots in the said Sector are being e-auctioned on 17.11.2023.

Served with the advance copy of the application, Mr. Deepak Sabherwal, Advocate, for the respondent-HSVP, is present in Court. He, on instructions, submits that the proposed e-auction has since been

cancelled/withdrawn. He prays for a short accommodation to seek instructions even qua the grievances/relief prayed for by the petitioners.

Adjourned to 21.11.2023.

To be taken up immediately after urgent matters.”

Today, learned counsel for the respondents has placed before us a copy of the allotment letter dated 20.11.2023, which is retained on record as Mark ‘X’. A perusal thereof reveals that in lieu of the alternative plot No.2011, Sector 13-17, Panipat, the petitioner has now been allotted the original plot No.392, Sector 13-17, Panipat itself. It further indicates that the allotment shall be governed by the same terms and conditions set out in the allotment letter No.6365, dated 22.09.1993. And, the petitioner shall be free to obtain the actual physical possession of the site on any working day by visiting the concerned authority.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing further substantive survives in the petition and the same be disposed of accordingly.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.
