1. The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to quash the orders passed on 07.11.2016 and 19.09.2012. In substance, the petitioner claims that though he has the experience of working as a Laboratory Assistant for more than 15 years, however, he has not been promoted to the post of a Research Assistant.

2. The petitioner has admittedly been promoted as the Head Laboratory Attendant on 27.10.2016. Proceedings of the Departmental Promotion Committee have been attached wherein the petitioner has not been found fit for research work because the petitioner only holds a Bachelor's degree in Humanities. The promotion has been declined to the petitioner on the subjective satisfaction of the Departmental Promotion Committee. Hence, no ground to issue the writ, as prayed for,

is made out.

3. Dismissed.
4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
