The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.87 dated 06.05.2022 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 20.01.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

An affidavit of Ajaypal Singh, PPS, DSP, Sub Division Sangrur, dated 27.03.2023 has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 20.01.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 20.01.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
