1. Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.110 dated 24.06.2023, registered at Police Station Gate Lopoke, Amritsar, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 452, 148 and 149 IPC.
2. Vide order dated 27.07.2023, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 27.07.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mukhtiar Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 27.07.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
