1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner has already been reinstated in service but with regard to the claim for the arrears and back wages, the same has been kept pending due to the pendency of the present petition and as the present petition is not being pressed any further, the respondent be directed to decide the claim of the petitioner for the grant of arrears for the period the petitioner remained under suspension.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in case the claim qua arrears/back wages is pending, an appropriate order will be passed by the respondents within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of the copy of the present order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
