The present petition has been filed under section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, praying for issuance of direction to the official respondents No. 1 to 3, to register FIR against the private respondents No. 4 to 6 under Sections 379-B, 380, 457, 120-B, 506, 365, 341, 323, 295-A, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 and 54 of the Arms Act, 1959 as grave injustice has been meted out to the petitioners at the behest of respondents No. 4 to 6.

Keeping in view the vague prayer and pleadings in the present petition, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere in the matter.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, in accordance with law.
