1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in cross DDR No.25 dated 25.06.2023, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 452, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar, recorded in case FIR No.110 dated 24.06.2023 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 326, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.
2. Vide order dated 28.07.2023, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 28.07.2023, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Shishpal Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.07.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
