AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. The petitioner-Brij Mohan Sharma has filed the present civil revision under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate direction for modification of the order passed by the Appellate Court in Civil Appeal No.203 of 2023 and directing the Appellate Court to adjudicate the pending applications with further prayer that the operation of warrant of possession Annexure P-7 and the execution proceedings in Execution No.32 of 2022 may kindly be stayed till the pendency of civil appeal and its final adjudication by learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar.

2. Regarding this civil revision, status report was called which has been received vide letter No.295 dated 24.08.2023 which clearly indicates that along with the civil appeal, application under Order 41 Rule 5 CPC was filed. Notice was sent to the respondent for 17.08.2023, on which date the counsel for appellant did not appear however, Mr. Pawan Kumar Bhardwaj, Advocate appeared on behalf of the respondent and this

civil appeal was again adjourned to 18.09.2023. The status report indicates that the counsel for respondent appeared who is given another adjournment to file reply to the stay application. It is informed by the learned counsel for the petitioner that next date fixed in the case is 11.10.2023. The status report indicates that stay application is still pending for consideration. The learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar is directed to dispose of the application under Order 41 Rule 5 CPC as per law expeditiously.

Accordingly, the present civil revision stands disposed of.
