1 The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to quash the order dated 27.08.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by the CJM, Kapurthala, whereby, the prayer of the petitioner to hold inquiry by the Magistrate was declined.

2. A short reply by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Kapurthala, has been filed on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 5 and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the charges have already been ordered to be framed against the accused on 03.01.2022 and out of total twenty witnesses, four witnesses have already been examined before the trial Court.

4. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.
