After arguing for some time, statement is made by learned counsel for the petitioner so as to withdraw this petition. However, learned counsel seeks liberty to plead guilty before the Trial Court and requests to direct the Trial Court to take lenient view of imposing fine only upon the petitioner as the complaint in question wherein the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person, has already been compromised between the parties and offence under the Section 174-A IPC (Ist part) is punishable with imprisonment or fine.

Dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for with the liberty to the petitioner to plead guilty before the Trial Court concerned. The Trial Court shall sympathetically consider the request of the petitioner to take lenient view of imposing fine only under Section 174-A IPC, in accordance with law.
