By way of this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.68 dated 06.06.2023 (wrongly mentioned as 18.06.2023 in the impugned order/ Annexure P-4) under Sections 308, 323, 324, 34 IPC at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda, District Bathinda, Punjab.

On instructions from HC Amrik Singh, it is informed by learned State Counsel that Section 308 IPC has since been deleted on 02.08.2023 and the same has been replaced by Section 325 IPC. Learned State counsel further submits that now all the offences in question under Sections 323, 324, 325, 34 IPC are bailable.

In view of the afore-said, learned Counsel for petitioner has made a statement that the present petition has become infructuous and the petitioner shall approach the trial Court concerned for seeking bail.
