Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that notice of motion was issued by this Court on 31.07.2023 and it was directed that the arrest of the appellant shall remain stayed. He further submitted that the appellant has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel has stated on instructions from DSP Gaurav Sharma that the appellant has already joined investigation and he is fully cooperating with the investigation process and he is not required for custodial interrogation. He further submitted that Section 302 of the IPC was also deleted.

In view of the aforesaid position, the present appeal is allowed. It is directed that in case in future the appellant is required to join the investigation process then he shall join the investigation and cooperate fully with the

investigation process and in the event of his arrest, the appellant be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.
