The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.363 dated 27.04.2023 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 307 and 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 307 IPC deleted and Section 308 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Samalkha, Panipat.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 28.07.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The reply dated 16.10.2023 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 28.07.2023

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In this view of the matter, interim order dated 28.07.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
