The petitioner while praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to challenge her transfer from the District Jail, Rupnagar to the Female Jail, Ludhiana, prays for a direction to the respondents to permit her to continue at Rupnagar. The petitioner claims that on her request she was transferred from Ludhiana to Rupnagar on 18.06.2019, whereas within a period of one month, she was wrongly transferred back to Ludhiana. Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that though the transfer order has been passed on the administrative grounds, however, the respondents have failed to disclose the reasons thereof.

The transfer is an incidence of the service. On account of an interim order passed by this Court on 14.08.2019, the petitioner has continued to work at District Jail, Rupnagar, for a period of nearly 4 years. Hence, at this stage, no ground to issue the writ, as prayed for, is made out.

Dismissed.
