1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue directions to respondent No. 2 to file challan/report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No. 260 dated 25.10.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 34 and 427 IPC (later on added Section 326 IPC), Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amrisar Rural. A further prayer has also been made for setting aside the communication (Annexure P-6), whereby, the respondent No. 5 has sought the constitution of the Medical Board to re-examine the petitioner, who had suffered the injuries in the incident dated 18.10.2018.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh submits that the opinion of the medical board, in pursuance to

Annexure P-6, is still pending. Learned State counsel has further assured the Court that investigation in case FIR No. 260 dated 25.10.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 34 and 427 IPC (later on added Section 326 IPC), Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amrisar Rural shall be conducted fairly and impartially and he further submits that the final report in the present case shall be submitted before the competent Court within a period of 08 weeks from today.

3. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is, accordingly, disposed off.
