It is not in dispute that the petitioner belongs to the Oustees category for the part of his land which was acquired. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner, therefore, asserts that the petitioner would be entitled for allotment of a plot under the said category.

Let the petitioner apply for the plot under the Oustees category within a period of two weeks from today by submitting an application to the Competent Authority, which shall thereafter proceed to consider the same and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of submission of such application, as per his entitlement according to the policy dated 25.05.2011. While passing the orders, respondents will take into consideration the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.23908 of 2012, titled as 'Surjit Kaur Vs. State of Punjab and others' (P-3).

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
