In compliance of order dated 20.09.2023 of this Court, learned counsel for the respondents produced result of the candidates including the petitioner which indicates that petitioner has actually secured 117.77 marks and in the information supplied under Right to Information Act, 2005, it was wrongly reported as 117.85 marks.
2. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that 116 posts are still lying vacant and respondents may be directed to consider claim of the petitioner against the vacant posts.
3. The petition stands disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider claim of the petitioner, in accordance with law, against the vacant posts.
