The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.208 dated 06.07.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 452, 506, 325 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Chappar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the complainant has filed his power of attorney along with no objection from the earlier counsel in the Court today which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Khushbir Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 29.08.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.08.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
