1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India claiming that the statutory appeal filed by the petitioner is pending with the appellate authority since 20.07.2023.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset prays for deciding the appeal filed by the petitioner dated 20.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously by passing a speaking order within a time bound frame.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Manbir Singh Batth, Advocate, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the appeal filed by the petitioner shall be decided expeditiously.

7. Since the statutory appeal is still pending and yet to be decided, it will be in the interest of justice that no further recovery be effected from the petitioner.
