1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India claiming that the statutory appeals filed by the petitioners is pending with the appellate authority since 17.07.2023 and 18.07.2023 respectively.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset prays for deciding the appeals filed by the petitioners dated 17.07.2023 and 18.07.2023 (Annexure P-2 and Annexure P-3) expeditiously by passing a speaking order within a time bound frame.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Charanjit Sharma, Advocate, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the appeals filed by the petitioners shall be decided expeditiously.

7. Since the statutory appeals are still pending and yet to be decided, it will be in the interest of justice that no further recovery be effected from the petitioners.
8. The petition stands disposed off.
