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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the Reference Order dated 14.05.2014 (Annexure P-1), vide which respondent No. 4 (Industrial Tribunal, Panipat) has been called upon to adjudicate the dispute as raised by the workmen of a faction of Atlas Mazdoor Union (INTUC), vide demand notice dated 31.12.2012 (Annexure P-2), served upon petitioner-Management by faction (respondent No. 3).

2. At the outset, learned counsel for petitioner submits that the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous as the factory stands closed and all the workers have taken their all dues.
